Kitchenuhmaykoosib Inninuwug and De Beers Canada hold discussions

Toronto, 25 August 2009 - Kitchenuhmaykoosib Inninuwug (KI) and De Beers Canada Inc. held discussions on 24 August 2009 about possible future exploration within the traditional lands of the KI. Both parties agreed that the discussion was useful and constructive, and agreed that the dialogue should continue.

The President of De Beers Canada, Jim Gowans, said that his conversation with Chief Donnie Morris clearly showed that the community is receptive to exploration and development that is undertaken responsibly, and follows meaningful dialogue with the community.
