Reporting to the Chief Engineer and working a two (2) weeks in / two (2) weeks out rotation at the Snap Lake Mine, this position will manage, co-ordinate and control mining engineering and planning functions, including trade off/opportunity studies, estimates and conceptual design work, to ensure effective management and recovery of mineral resources.

Responsibilities include:

- Determining and evaluating production scheduling in order to meet present and future targets;
- Collaborating on geotechnical plans including room and pillar design, ground support standards, backfill testing and optimization and modeling of extraction sequence;
- Developing and implementing the underground ventilation plan including design, auditing, systems optimization and meeting regulatory reporting requirements;
- Providing technical support to the mine operation department in the areas of drilling, charging and blasting; and
- Undertaking trade-off studies and producing comprehensive reports, drawings, estimates, financial analysis and recommendations taking into account recognized practices, cost control, safety and compliance with the applicable regulations.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree in Mining Engineering with at least five (5) to seven (7) years of experience in a fully mechanized underground environment.
