This position works a four (4) days on / three (3) days off rotation at the Snap Lake Mine and as such will require the incumbent to reside in Yellowknife, NT.

Key responsibilities:

- Preparing short, medium and long-term maintenance and operation services plans;
- Developing and implementing technical standards, specifications and quality assurance systems to optimize integrity of processes;
- Directing, coordinating and integrating all technical aspects of operational and shutdown maintenance projects in accordance with the project requirements including scheduling, procurement plans and work plans;
- Developing, implementing and sustaining an asset management strategy in line with Corporate standards,
- Providing site-wide management and leadership for the successful implementation of the reliability-focused maintenance management operating system; and
- Coordinating, preparing and submitting working cost and capital budgets and analyzing and reviewing on a monthly basis.

Requirements:

- Professional Engineer with eligibility for registration in the NWT with a minimum of ten (10) years of relevant experience, five (5) years of which must be at the maintenance engineering management level.
- Previous experience in maintenance of process facilities, mechanized underground mining, diesel power generation and the ability to work in a highly technical cross-cultural environment is desired.
